The set menu, which is priced at AED 498, starts with a 'Yu Sheng' smoked salmon salad as a welcome from the chef and a Xingfu dim sum trio boasting a baked truffle duck puff, tiger prawn dumpling, and wild mushroom puff. Main dishes include baked cornfed spatchcock with morel mushroom, wok-fried seabass, Wagyu rib eye with osmanthus sauce, and XO sauce lobster egg fried rice. A gold tiger-striped orange dark chocolate firecracker and mandarin sorbet will round the evening and mark the end of the luxurious feast.

Keeping with the theme, diners can also indulge in a King of Fujian cocktail inspired by the Chinese tiger's original habitat of the Fujian province, created in partnership with Ketel One vodka. Priced at AED 80, the tropical serve includes kumquat, a symbol of good luck, passion fruit, lychee, lemon juice and basil leaves, beautifully garnished with edible gold leaf in a coupe glass, featuring a playful tiger print.



The long-standing tradition of constructing a wishing tree within Hakkasan restaurants worldwide will continue this year, bringing good fortune in the Year of the Tiger. Guests of Hakkasan Dubai are invited to write their wishes on a red ribbon before tying it to the restaurant's wall latticing in hopes that they will come true in the coming year.
