The Iftar buffet will be available from sunset until 8:30pm. The minimum spend for Suhoor is AED 180 per person for weekdays and weekends, with food being served from 10:00pm until 2:30am. Guests are welcome to stay and enjoy the tent until 3:00am.

Helmed by the talented Ali El Bourji, Executive Arabic Chef at Atlantis Dubai, Bourji is set to create an experience unlike any other including an exquisite selection of Ramadan favourites such as Jordanian lamb mansaf, lamb ouzi, and western carving station. Guests can also look forward to a variety of dessert stations, including a traditional live, Arabic sweet-making station, hot favourites such as kunafa, osmaliya with ashta, as well as an ice cream station, continental assorted pastry, and chocolate fountain. - Set menu is charged at AED 255 per person for weekdays and weekends.
- Early bird offers are available until 16th February with bookings valid within the first 7 days of Ramadan at the rate of AED 235 per person for weekdays and weekends.
- Iftar is from Sunset until 8:30pm.
- All bookings must be guaranteed by credit card.

<u>Suhoor</u>

- The minimum spend is AED 180 per person for weekdays and weekends.
- Early bird offers are available until 16th February with bookings valid within the first 7 days of Ramadan at a rate of AED 235 per person for weekdays and weekends.
- Suhoor will be from 10:00pm to 3:00am, with the last order at 2:30am.
- All bookings must be guaranteed by credit card.
- Pregnant women and guests under 21 years of age are not permitted inside the tent during Suhoor as per Dubai Law.

Dress Code

- Smart Casual dress code: minimum of long trousers (no shorts), t-shirts with sleeves and any footwear is allowed for your comfort.
- Dress code is applicable for children of all ages.

Atlantis, The Palm's Asateer Tent will sit in a unique setting overlooking the Arabian Gulf and Palm Island, with a backdrop of Dubai's stunning skyline, which creates a tranquil and relaxed atmosphere. The meaning of Asateer translates to 'myths' of authentic Arabia, which is reflected in the ambience and embellishments of the tent.
