most influential figures in the bar industry, van Beek was also recognised for running the most creative cocktail programme in the Netherlands for two consecutive years from 2018 to 2019.

With over 17 years of industry experience, Spanish-Italian native Angelo, is the architect and driving force behind Nobu Dubai's enhanced beverage programme. A trailblazer in the mixology community of Dubai, Immorlano has been at the helm of the Nobu Dubai beverage program since 2022.
